LIVE SENT TO YOUR NEIGHBORS

5 ways to LIVE SENT when you're stuck at home!

It seems like a paradox to live sent when the world is saying to stay put! Even so, here are 5 easy ways to leverage who you are and what you've been given for the sake of the gospel in your neighborhood. Every Christian can do these!

- Get to know your neighbors. Go outside. Take a walk. You'll see more neighbors than normal. Say hello. Learn names. Get to know your neighbors because they are worth getting to know. You never know how God might use this new relationship somewhere down the road.
- 2. **Pray for your neighbors.** Ideally, you will know some neighbors well enough to pray by name and with insight. Write down names and specific prayers for those you know. For those you don't know, pray generally. Above all, pray that each neighbor would know, accept, and live in the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- 3. **Invite your neighbors to online church.** Shandon offers four online worship services every Sunday and multiple online small groups. Invite others who are not connected to connect with a small group at shandon.org/connect.
- 4. Serve your neighbors. One simple way to serve is to run errands for neighbors who are vulnerable. If you know them well enough arrange this with a phone call. Otherwise, write a note and place it on the front door, letting them know who you are and how to reach you if they need an errand run. Make sure your hands are clean and leave the items in a designated spot like the front door.
- 5. **Have a gospel conversation with a neighbor.** Every conversation has the potential to be a gospel conversation. Look for an opportunity to share the gospel with a neighbor by asking about how they are dealing with the brokenness of our world. Point to your own hope and be open about your own brokenness. This video will help prepare you to have a gospel conversation.
