SHANDON COVID GUIDELINES

We strive to maintain a healthy and safe environment for our children and staff. Due to COVID-19 we are implementing new guidelines which are subject to change. In order Somr. to comply with recommendations of all governmental health agencies, we ask that you follow these guidelines. Kids Ministry Volunteers, Weekday Teachers, and children.

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ARRIVAL

- NO fever above 100.4
- NO chills, cough, runny nose, sneezing, congestion, sore or scratchy throat, headache, muscle or body aches, shortness of breath or difficult breathy, diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting, pink eyes.

WEEKDAY TEACHERS **AND CHILDREN**

- NO Symptoms of any childhood diseases such as measles, mumps, chicken pox, whooping cough, hand-foot-mouth, etc...
- NO unexplained rash, skin infection
- Untreated pink eye or other type eye infection
- NO lice, including the presence of eggs or nits
- NO Exposure to COVID-19

TEACHER & CLASSROOM INTERACTION

We feel it is important for our children to be able to see our face and expressions to help them learn and process so we will allow our teachers to stand 6 feet away from the children inside the classroom for circle time with their masks pulled down.

We will work hard to limit their contact with other classmates outside of their own room with activities such as playground time. Each classroom will have their own time on the playground and we will encourage hand sanitizer and handwashing before and after time on the playground.

HANDWASHING

We will continue to encourage handwashing often throughout the day.

CLEANING

Operations and Kid's Ministry staff will continue to provide daily cleaning and disinfecting of our classrooms, toys and equipment.

MASKS

MASKS are to be worn if you are within 6 feet of a child and is recommend with other adults if you are not vaccinated. MASKS are not required for our preschoolers. If a parent insists their child wear their masks, remind them we will try our best to help the child wear their mask. We are not responsible for lost or misplaced masks.
