

Consent for Release of Minor Child

In an age of independence and busy family schedules, a Parent/Guardian may choose to drop off a child under the age of 12 for a lesson or other Worship Arts Center event. Although we prefer to always have a responsible adult accompanying a minor, we understand that some unforeseen circumstances might necessitate otherwise. In order for us to provide reasonable protection for our Students, we do require a signed consent form that permits a minor under the age of 12 to be released from a lesson or event without an accompanying adult.

- We reserve the right to revoke this consent at any time if we determine that unaccompanied release is not in the best interest of the child, or if unsupervised behavior becomes problematic.
- The Parent/Guardian signing this form has to be legally authorized to provide consent.
- The Parent/Guardian who is authorized to provide consent may not necessarily be the one who is paying for lessons.
- Please confirm with our office that all parental contact information is current.
- The Parent/Guardian must be available by phone during the lesson or event.
